

## David Barclay Utility Analyst, Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Planning

Our next speaker, David Barclay, will speak to us about leveraging existing knowledge resources around the State to address energy efficiency and briefly describe some of the energy efficiency programs that are being offered by Florida utilities to address the needs of low income customers.

David began his career at Gainesville Regional Utilities in 2005 as a Utility Analyst working within the Strategic Planning department. Currently he is the lead analyst for energy efficiency and renewable energy planning. In this role David oversees demand side management (DSM) modeling to support program design and implementation as well as identification and development of potential renewable energy projects.

David is the first chair of the Florida Municipal Energy Efficiency Committee (FMEC), a collaborative group of municipal utilities in Florida with representation from OUC, JEA, Lakeland Electric, The City of Tallahassee, the Florida Municipal Electric Association and the Florida Municipal Power Agency, the formation FMEC marks the first time these organizations have joined together to work specifically on DSM planning.
